

**HUNDREDS GATHERED TO BE PART OF REDLANDS' HISTORY

REDLANDS, CA— Hundreds of babies, ranging from three-year-olds to newborns, scattered the parking lot between the Morey Mansion and Redlands Community Hospital Saturday, June 6. Families enjoyed their Saturday afternoon as they became a part of the traditional 'Baby Day' event where a DJ provided entertainment and refreshments were served.

The tiny tots, their siblings and parents became part of Inland Empire history during the giant photo session as babies born from 2006 to present got in line to get their 'group picture' taken. The babies and their families were separated by year and were photographed alongside their families and Jim Holmes, CEO and President of Redlands Community Hospital.

The Baby Day Photo tradition began in 1929 and even with more than 2,000 babies born annually, the hospital has reinstated the tradition and plans to take the historic photo every two years. Previous Baby Day photos have been enlarged and are displayed in the hospital. The hospital plans to host the next Baby Day event in 2012.
