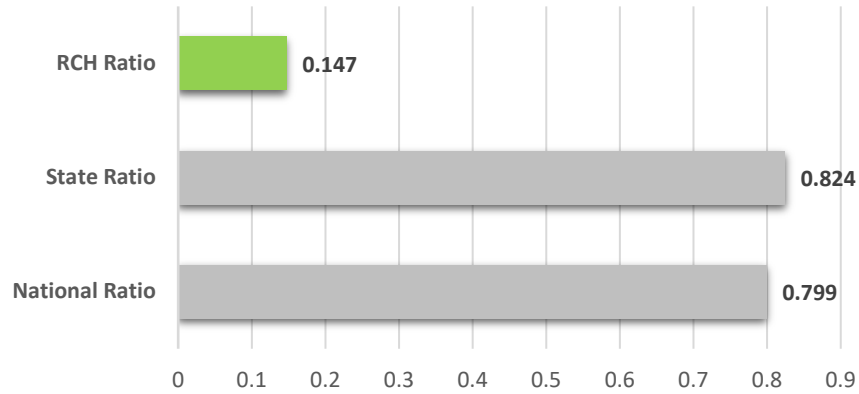

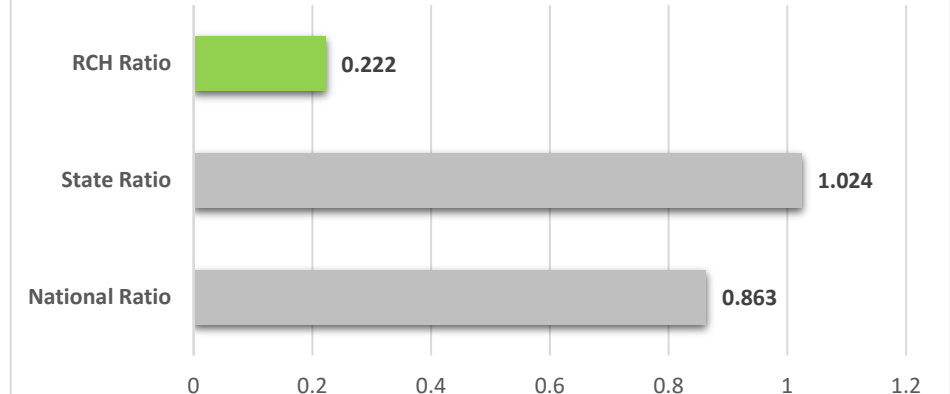

A central line is a narrow tube inserted into a large blood vessel to give important medical treatment. When inserted incorrectly or not kept clean, central lines can become an easy way for germs to enter the body and cause serious infections in the blood.
