



Redlands Community Hospital General Visitation

As of September 17, 2022, visitors are no longer required to show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test for visitation.

Visitors must continue to comply with CDPH Masking Guidance while visiting indoors, as outlined in the State Public Health Order.

Redlands Community Hospital encourages visitation to support family members during their hospital stay. While visiting, please adhere to the following visitation COVID-19 guidance to keep everyone safe and healthy:

- **Visitation hours** are between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- **Two (2) visitors or support persons** per patient will be allowed at the same time.
- **Visitors must wear a well-fitted surgical face mask** over the nose and mouth at all times while visiting, in keeping with State guidelines regardless of vaccination status.
- **All visitors will be screened** at the hospital entrance for fever and COVID-19 symptoms and must sign in.
- **Please check with the unit nurse** prior to bringing any food, personal items or flowers. Restrictions on these items may be an important part of your loved one's care.
- **Once inside the hospital**, please proceed directly to the patient's room or designated waiting area. Please do not wander the facility.

Children in Hospital:

Children under the age of 18 will not be permitted at this time.

Emergency Department:

Visitors are permitted inside the Emergency Department.

Labor and Delivery:

In addition to support persons(s), a doula will be permitted with prior arrangements required.
